This job title is to be used only during Summer Quarter for RAs who are not registered but who are employed to do research tasks that would normally be provided by graduate research assistants in titles covered by the UW/UAW Local 4121 Contract.

Under Article 24 of the UW/UAW ASE Contract, GRSAs must be paid at least the equivalent rates for the positions for which they would qualify if registered and paid via a regular salaried RA position. GRSAs may be appointed to higher classification pay rates at the discretion of the departments or hiring units.

A graduate student who IS REGISTERED for summer quarter and doing bargaining unit research work must be paid on an FTE basis as a salaried (not hourly) RA using the their respective salary schedules.

PLEASE NOTE: GRSAs should be paid at least the minimum rates corresponding to the rates paid by their academic departments regardless of where they are employed on campus.
